SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES OFFERED BY THE UNIVERSITY FOR THE SESSION 2016-2017

The Manav Bharti University is going to offer various scholarship schemes from the upcoming session 2016-17 for the different categories of students, bonafide residents of Himachal Pradesh to encourage the students for higher education in different fields of education and to improve their merit/performance in various courses being run by the University.

1. 1st Year B.Tech. Tuition Fee Free for HP Bonafide Students

This scheme is meant for the students who will take admission in B.Tech. course run by the University. The eligibility criteria for this is minimum 60% marks in the qualifying examination i.e. +2 level and at Diploma level. This scheme is open to all the students who belong to Himachal Pradesh. The scholarship will not be renewed for the 2nd year onwards.

2. Scholarship to Economically Weaker Section

This scholarship will be awarded to the students belonging to the SC/ST/OBC categories. The eligibility criteria for this scholarship is 60% marks in the qualifying examination. The scholarship will be renewed for the 2nd year only if the scholar obtains minimum 55% marks in the annual examination/aggregate 55% marks in both the semesters where semester system is followed. The students seeking scholarship under this scheme will have to apply for the scholarship on the prescribed proforma alongwith Bonafide resident certificate and category certificate(i.e. SC/ST/OBC) issued by the Tehsildar/SDM of the illaqua.

3. Scholarship for Single Girl Child Students:

With a view to encourage the girls of the state for higher education, the Manav Bharti University proposes to start a scheme of scholarship exclusively for those girls who are the only child of their parents. The number of scholarships proposes to be awarded under this scheme is 5 at bachelor and 5 at master

degree level courses. The girl student seeking scholarship under this scheme will have to produce a certificate to the effect that she is the only child of her parents issued by the Pradhan of the Panchayat duly countersigned by the Tehsildar alongwith certificate of bonafide resident. The scholarship will be renewed for the next year only if the student passes her annual examination being conducted by the University.

4. Scholarship to Meritorious Students

The scholarship under this scheme will be awarded to such students of the_state as well as outside the State on the basis of marks obtained in last qualifying examination:

75% above marks	30% in Tuition Fee
70% to 74.99% marks	20% in Tuition Fee
65% to 69.99% marks	10% in Tuition Fee
