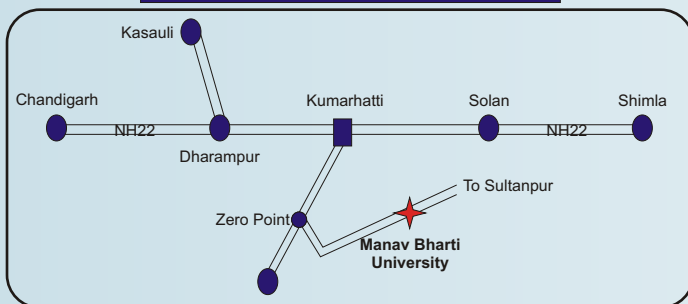


About MBU
