



Briefing on Pharmacy Conference

Manav Bharti University organized 1st National conference on “Emerging Trends in Pharmaceutical Sciences” on 29th - 30th Sep. 2012. Around 250 delegates consisting UG Students, Research scholars & Industrial person participated in this event. More than 200 abstracts were submitted by delegates of different states like Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Punjab, Delhi, Karnataka, M.P, Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh & U.P. etc. of the country. There were total 230 abstracts out of which 63 abstracts in Pharmaceutics, Biopharmaceutics, Clinical & Hospital pharmacy, 51 in Pharmaceutical Chemistry & applied Chemistry, 47 in Pharmacology & Toxicology, 30 in Pharmacognosy, Phytochemistry & Ayurveda & 27 in Pharmaceutical Biotechnology, Bioinformatics & Microbiology.

On first day, the first technical session was cheered by Dr. A. C. Rana.

First lecture was given by 'Mr. Rahul Teneja' Project Officer, Intellectual Property facilitation center, Haryana State council of science & Technology, Panchkula. His topic was on intellectual property right and pharmaceutical applications, in which he gave us valuable information regarding patents, industrial design, trademarks, geographical indication of goods, trade secrets, copy right & other right such as moral & economic right. As a token of gratitude a certificate & memento was presented to him.

Second lecture was given by 'Dr. G. D. Gupta' Director, ASBASISM, college of pharmacy, Bela. His topic was 'Recent technologies in pulsatile drug delivery system'. Dr. Gupta made us aware about controlled release drug delivery system & pulsatile drug delivery system. He shared his vast experience with us. He was also presented with memento & certificate.

Technical session –II were cheered by Dr. S. P. Bhardwaj, vice chancellor Manav Bharti university & Dr. Om Prakash, Pro-vice –chancellor Manav Bharti university, Solan. There was one lecture in this session delivered by Dr. D. D. Gupta, Dept. of Pharmacology, IGMC, Shimla. His topic was 'Therapeutic Alliance' He told us about interaction between doctor and patient in which he compiled patient compliance & doctor compliance. He was also presented with certificate & memento.

Technical session-III were cheered by Dr. Om Prakash and Dr. Sukhbir Lal. The lecture was given by Dr. A. C. Rana, Director, Rayat institute of Pharmacy, Ropar. The topic was 'Applications of Biostatistics in Clinical trials'. Dr. Rana gave us useful information about clinical trials & told us how statistics can be used in clinical trials. He was presented with memento and certificate.

Second lecture was delivered by Dr. Babita Khosla, Dept. of Environmental Sciences, Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak. Her topic was phosphate solubilizing microbes as environmental managers. She told us how phosphate solubilizing microbes help us in mobilizing unavailable phosphorus in soil to available form. Her lecture was very informative. She was also presented with memento and certificate.

Third lecture was delivered by Dr. K. K. Parashar, Dept of Ayurveda Pharmacy, Manav Bharti University, Solan. His topic was "Ayurvedic Science" and Dr. Parashar made us aware about ayurvedic medicines. He was also presented with memento and certificate
